Chairman Powell welcomed the Committee and turned the floor over to Sean Ostrow of the Revisor of Statutes Office to review the balloon amendment to <a href="https://example.com/HB2709"><u>HB2709 establishing the restitution value for unlawfully taken antlered whitetail deer.</u></a>

Mr. Ostrow distributed copies of House Substitute Bill 2709. Mr. Ostrow reviewed the bill by explaining substitute bill amends provisions of the bill relating to the restitution value of deer, antelope and elk taken in violation of the big game hunting provisions of the state.

**Section 1** – amends the criminal trespass provision to include entering any property marked a private land in accordance with K.S.A. 32-1013 (section 4 of the bill). Criminal trespass is a class B misdemeanor.

Section 2 – amends the criminal hunting statute to make it a strict liability offense for hunting on land that is marked properly in accordance with K.S.A. 32-1013.

Section 3 – under penalty provisions in (e)(1) commercialization of wildlife. The amendment allows the court to revoke an offender's permits and any equipment used to commit the offense for a period of time up to as long as the offender's lifetime; current law is 10 years.

**Section 4** –Markings on land by use of paint marks as provided in subsection (b) shall be bright orange as opposed to the current purple markings.

**Section 5** – The formula for measuring the antlers or horns to determine the value shall be promulgated by rules and regulations of the secretary.

**Section 6** – The bill would take effect on January 1, 2013 to give the secretary time to provide notice of the new provisions to effected parties and implement rules and regs for the calculation of the restitution values. (Attachment 1)
