The Chair introduced Dr. Edward Hammon, President, Ft. Hays State University. Dr. Hammond gave a brief description of the Voyager Class of the Kansas Academy of Mathematics and Science of Ft. Hays State University.

<u>Senate Substitute for HB 2200 - concerning school districts; relating to state aid for capital improvements and capital outlay.</u>

<u>Senator Schmidt made a motion, seconded by Senator Wagle to reconsider **Senate Substitute for HB**</u>
<u>2200 in order to consider an amendment by Senator King.</u>

A motionwas made by Senator Teichman and seconded by Senator Abrams to approve the committee minutes for March 12 and 13. The motion passed.

Senator King made a motion, seconded by Senator Schmidt to add a provision that states that the \$74 increase in base state aid per pupil will not go into effect for either year unless the equalization aid increases to 92.5 percent in school year 2012-13 and 100 percent in school year 2013-14. Otherwise, the base state aid per pupil would remain at \$3,780. The motion passed.

Senator Teichman made a motion, seconded by Senator Hensley to pass out **Senate Substitute for HB 2200**, as amended, favorably for passage. The motion passed.

The meeting was adjourned at 2:30. There are no more meetings scheduled at this time.
