The Chair called the meeting to order.

Action on

<u>SB 136 - No cause of action for recovery of certain losses while operating an uninsured motor vehicle</u>

The Chair asked Lee Wright, Farmers Insurance, to answer any questions the committee might have regarding <u>SB 136</u>. Mr. Wright said non economic damages are defined as damages for pain and suffering. He said this bill is the no-pay no-play bill. He said we are after an uninsured owner of a vehicle driving his vehicle or another uninsured vehicle. The uninsured owner can not recover for non economic damages. In other words, he can not recover for pain and suffering. He noted the out of pocket expenses are still covered, just not pain and suffering.

Senator Olson moved to pass out SB 136 favorably. Senator Masterson seconded. Motion passed.

The Chair said <u>SB 206</u> is the NCOIL model for SLIMPACT LITE which is the surplus line of insurance. She said she has put this bill in a subcommittee to be chaired by Senator Longbine. Other members of the subcommittee are Senator Merrick and Senator Schmidt. She said some mechanism has to be in place by 2013 to make sure the state collects the premiums for the surplus line.

The next meeting is scheduled for March 2, 2011.
