The Chairman turned the Committee's attention to **SB 366 –Relating to attachment and garnishment.**

Additional written testimony relating to refunding of over-payments and a proposed amendment was submitted by Helen Pedigo. The amendment concerns the court's role in the garnishee proceedings and the release of funds, credits or indebtedness that have been attached. (Attachment 1).

Senator Vratil suggested that the language in the the third line of the boxed-inserts on pages 2 and 3 be modified to change the word “court” to “judgment creditor”.
