SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2078 by House Committee on Education

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2078 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

Under current law, the School for the Blind is permitted to conduct training programs only during the summer; however, the School for the Deaf can hold training sessions at any time during the year. HB 2078 would allow the School for the Blind to also conduct training programs year round.

According to the School for the Blind, enactment of HB 2078 would have no fiscal effect. All training programs are financed by fees imposed on those accessing the services.
