SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2133 by Joint Committee on Special Claims against the State

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2133 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2133 would direct agencies to pay claims against the state from their existing State General Fund appropriations and special revenue funds in FY 2011. The claims in this bill affect the Departments of Revenue, Corrections, and Wildlife and Parks, the University of Kansas, Kansas Highway Patrol, Governmental Ethics Commission, Department of Health and Environment, and Board of Technical Professions.
