
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2202 by House Committee on Education

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2202 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2202 would allow the State Board of Education to offer and operate a nontraditional teacher licensure program. The Board would be authorized to provide grants of financial assistance to organizations that train individuals seeking to obtain nontraditional teacher licenses, subject to appropriation.

Although HB 2202 authorizes a grant program for nontraditional teacher licenses, the bill the bill would be subject to appropriation. Any fiscal effect associated with HB 2202 is not reflected in *The FY 2012 Governor's Budget Report*.
