
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2344 by House Committee on Federal and State Affairs

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2344 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2344 would require a permanency plan for a child in out-of-home placement to include the names of all relative placement alternatives that were considered. If a relative placement is not selected, the reason must be documented.

Passage of HB 2344 would have no fiscal effect.
