**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for HB 2519 by House Committee on Insurance

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2519 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

Current law requires that, if asked, potential employees of certain occupations must disclose any previous arrests, convictions, or diversions that have been expunged by the court. HB 2519 would add individuals to the list of those who must provide such information, if requested, on an application for a license to engage in the business of insurance. The bill also includes technical reconciling amendments as the result of recodification of criminal code.

HB 2519, if implemented, would have no fiscal effect.
