
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 152 by Senate Committee on Natural Resources

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 152 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 152 would amend existing law concerning hunting by allowing persons who have a concealed carry license to carry concealed firearms while lawfully hunting and allowing the use of firearms suppression devices while lawfully hunting.

Passage of SB 152 would have no fiscal effect.
