
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 172 by Senator Hensley, et al.

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 172 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 172 would prohibit any elected or appointed official, legislator, statewide office holder, or member of the State Board of Education from engaging in lobbying or being employed as a lobbyist within two years or leaving state office. The bill would take effect on January 1, 2012.

The Governmental Ethics Commission indicates that SB 172 would have no fiscal effect on state revenues or expenditures.
