SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 334 by Senate Committee on Transportation


In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 334 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 334 would authorize the Director of Vehicles of the Department of Revenue to waive a skills test required for persons applying for a commercial driver's license if the applicant provides evidence of military commercial vehicle driving experience and has satisfied the criteria established in Title 49 of the Code of Federal Regulations Part 383.77.

The Department of Revenue estimates that SB 334 would increase expenditures from the Division of Vehicles Operating Fund by \$3,792 in FY 2013 for 24 hours of programming time at \$158 per hour to update the Motor Vehicle Registration System.
