3 4 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 5 Section 1. (a) As used in this section: (1) "Pornographic materials" means: 6 7 (A) Any obscene material or performance depicting sexual 8 conduct, sexual contact or a sexual performance; and 9 (B) any visual depiction, including any photograph, film, video, 10 picture or computer or computer-generated image or picture, whether made or produced by electronic, mechanical or other means, of 11 12 sexually explicit conduct. (2) "Sexually violent crime" shall have the meaning ascribed 13 thereto in K.S.A. 22-4902, and amendments thereto. 14 15 (b) On and after July 1, 2011, when an adult is arrested or charged with the commission or attempted commission of a sexually violent 16 17 crime, a law enforcement officer responding to the scene of the crime 18 shall report on the evidence collection form evidence Kansas standard 19 offense report the presence of pornographic materials found: 20 (1) At the scene of the crime; 21 on the person arrested of the crime; 22 (3) at the residence of the person arrested of the crime; and 23 in the vehicle of the person arrested of the crime. 24 Report of materials found pursuant to the provisions of 25 subsection (b) shall be used for statistical purposes only. (d) The Kansas bureau of investigation shall: 26 27 (1) Make the necessary changes to the Kansas standard offense 28 report and the Kansas incident based reporting system handbook; 29 30 (2) shall promulgate rules and regulations concerning the 31 training for law enforcement agencies to implement the provisions 32 of this section.
