AN ACT concerning the department of administration; relating to the requirements for purchase of motor vehicles by state agencies.

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Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

- Section 1. (a) As used in this section:
- (1) "Motor vehicle" has the meaning provided by K.S.A. 79-3401, and amendments thereto;
 - (2) "secretary" means the secretary of administration;
- (3) "state agency" has the meaning provided by K.S.A. 75-3701, and amendments thereto.
- (b) Whenever any state agency purchases a motor vehicle, the state agency shall submit to the secretary an inspection and condition report of the motor vehicle sought to be replaced by the state agency. The inspection and condition report shall be in a form prescribed by the secretary and shall include, but is not limited to the:
 - (1) Warranty and motor vehicle maintenance history;
 - (2) odometer mileage of the motor vehicle;
 - (3) condition of the interior of the motor vehicle:
 - (4) condition of the motor vehicle's exterior body; and
 - (5) condition of the mechanical components of the motor vehicle.
- (c) The fact that the motor vehicle sought to be replaced by the state agency has met or exceeded 100,000 miles on the motor vehicle's odometer shall not be the only factor in the state agency's determination that such motor vehicle requires replacement.
- (d) The secretary shall submit all inspection and condition reports to the appropriate budget committee of the house of representatives for review during the 2012 regular session of the legislature and all regular sessions thereafter.
- (e) The secretary shall adopt rules and regulations in order to implement the provisions of this section.
 - Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.

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
