

HOUSE BILL No. 2380

1 AN ACT concerning the veterans benefit lottery game; disposition of net
2 profits; establishing the veterans benefit lottery game fund and the
3 national guard benefit lottery game fund.

5 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

6 Section 1. (a) All net profits received from the sale of veterans
7 benefit lottery game tickets, materials and games, as prescribed by rules
8 and regulations adopted pursuant to subsection (b) of K.S.A. 2010 Supp.
9 74-8724, and amendments thereto, shall be transferred to and credited to
10 the veterans benefit lottery game fund and the national guard benefit
11 lottery game fund in accordance with this section.

12 (b) On or before the fifth day of each month, the executive director of
13 the Kansas lottery shall determine and certify to the director of accounts
14 and reports the aggregate amount of net profits received from the sale of
15 veterans benefit game lottery tickets, materials and games, as prescribed
16 by rules and regulations adopted pursuant to subsection (b) of K.S.A. 2010
17 Supp. 74-8724, and amendments thereto, that was transferred from the
18 lottery operating fund to the state gaming revenues fund during the
19 preceding month pursuant to subsection (d) of K.S.A. 74-8711, and
20 amendments thereto. Upon receipt of each such certification, the director
21 of accounts and reports shall transfer the amount equal to 40% of the
22 amount certified from the state gaming revenues fund to the veterans
23 benefit lottery game fund established by section 2, and amendments
24 thereto, and shall transfer the amount equal to 60% of the amount certified
25 from the state gaming revenues fund to the national guard benefit lottery
26 game fund established by section 3, and amendments thereto. At the same
27 time as such certification is transmitted to the director of accounts and
28 reports, the executive director of the Kansas lottery shall transmit a copy
29 of such certification to the director of the budget and the director of
30 legislative research.

31 Sec. 2. (a) There is hereby established in the state treasury the
32 veterans benefit lottery game fund which shall be administered by the
33 Kansas commission on veterans affairs. All expenditures from the veterans
34 benefit lottery game fund shall be made in accordance with appropriation
35 acts upon warrants of the director of accounts and reports issued pursuant
36 to vouchers approved by the Kansas commission on veterans affairs or the

1 designee of the commission.

2 (b) Moneys credited to the veterans benefit lottery game fund shall
3 not be transferred to the state general fund. Moneys credited to the
4 veterans benefit lottery game fund shall be used only for the following
5 purposes in accordance with the following:

6 (1) Fifty percent of the moneys transferred to the veterans benefit
7 lottery game fund shall be used for operating expenditures and capital
8 improvements, or as otherwise provided by appropriation act, for the use
9 and benefit of the Kansas veterans' home, the Kansas soldiers' home and
10 the state veterans cemetery system in accordance with subsection (c)(2) of
11 K.S.A. 2010 Supp. 74-8724, and amendments thereto; and

12 (2) fifty percent of the moneys transferred to the veterans benefit
13 lottery game fund shall be used for a veterans enhanced service delivery
14 program in accordance with the provisions of subsection (c)(3) of K.S.A.
15 2010 Supp. 74-8724, and amendments thereto.

16 (c) On or before the 10th day of each month, the director of accounts
17 and reports shall transfer from the state general fund to the veterans benefit
18 lottery game fund interest earnings based on:

19 (1) The average daily balance of moneys in the veterans benefit
20 lottery game fund for the preceding month; and

21 (2) the net earnings rate of the pooled money investment portfolio for
22 the preceding month.

23 Sec. 3. (a) There is hereby established in the state treasury the
24 national guard benefit lottery game fund which shall be administered by
25 the adjutant general. All expenditures from the national guard benefit
26 lottery game fund shall be made in accordance with appropriation acts
27 upon warrants of the director of accounts and reports issued pursuant to
28 vouchers approved by the adjutant general or the designee of the adjutant
29 general.

30 (b) Moneys credited to the national guard benefit lottery game fund
31 shall not be transferred to the state general fund. Moneys credited to the
32 national guard benefit lottery game fund shall be used only for purposes
33 directly benefitting members of the Kansas army and air national guard
34 and their families to provide for Kansas national guard educational
35 assistance act scholarships pursuant to K.S.A. 74-32,145 et seq., and
36 amendments thereto, and, to the extent that moneys are available, for other
37 purposes directly benefitting members of the Kansas army and air national
38 guard and their families in accordance with the provisions of subsection
39 (c)(1) of K.S.A. 2010 Supp. 74-8724, and amendments thereto.

40 (c) On or before the 10th day of each month, the director of accounts
41 and reports shall transfer from the state general fund to the national guard
42 benefit lottery game fund interest earnings based on:

43 (1) The average daily balance of moneys in the national guard benefit

- 1 lottery game fund for the preceding month; and
- 2 (2) the net earnings rate of the pooled money investment portfolio for
- 3 the preceding month.
- 4 Sec. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
- 5 publication in the statute book.
