1 AN ACT concerning distinctive license plates; amending K.S.A. 8-1,148,
2 8-1,150 and 8-1,151 and K.S.A. 2011 Supp. **8-1,141**, 8-1,142, 8-1,153,
3 8-1,158, 8-1,161, 8-1,162 and 8-1,164 and repealing the existing
4 sections.
5

6 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

7 **Section 1. K.S.A. 2011 Supp. 8-1,141 is hereby amended to read as**
8 **follows: 8-1,141. (a) Any new distinctive license plate authorized for**
9 **issuance on and after July 1, 1994, shall be subject to the personalized**
10 **license plate fee prescribed by subsection (c) of K.S.A. 8-132, and**
11 **amendments thereto. This section shall not apply to any distinctive**
12 **license plate authorized prior to July 1, 1994.**

13 (b) The director of vehicles shall not issue any new distinctive
14 license plate authorized for issuance on and after July 1, 1995, unless
15 there is a guarantee of an initial issuance of at least 500 license plates.

16 (c) The provisions of this section shall not apply to distinctive
17 license plates issued under the provisions of K.S.A. 8-1,145, or K.S.A.
18 2011 Supp. 8-177d, 8-1,163 or 8-1,166, and amendments thereto.

19 (d) The provisions of subsection (a), shall not apply to distinctive
20 license plates issued under the provisions of K.S.A. 8-1,146 or 8-1,148,
21 and amendments thereto, or K.S.A. 2011 Supp. 8-1,153, 8-1,158 or 8-
22 1,161, and amendments thereto.

23 (e) The provisions of subsection (f) shall not apply to distinctive
24 license plates issued under the provisions of K.S.A. 2011 Supp. 8-1,160,
25 and amendments thereto, except that the division shall delay the
26 manufacturing and issuance of such distinctive license plate until the
27 division has received not less than 1,000 orders for such plate,
28 including payment of the personalized license plate fee required under
29 subsection (a). Upon certification by the director of vehicles to the
30 director of accounts and reports that not less than 1,000 paid orders
31 for such plate have been received, the director of accounts and reports
32 shall transfer \$40,000 from the state highway fund to the distinctive
33 license plate fund.

34 (f) (1) Any person or organization sponsoring any distinctive

1 license plate authorized by the legislature on and after July 1, 2004,
2 shall submit to the division of vehicles a nonrefundable amount not to
3 exceed \$20,000, to defray the division's cost for developing such
4 distinctive license plate.

5 (2) All moneys received under this subsection shall be remitted by
6 the secretary of revenue to the state treasurer in accordance with the
7 provisions of K.S.A. 75-4215, and amendments thereto. Upon receipt
8 of each such remittance, the state treasurer shall deposit the entire
9 amount in the state treasury to the credit of the distinctive license
10 plate fund which is hereby created in the state treasury. All moneys
11 credited to the distinctive license plate fund shall be used by the
12 department of revenue only for the purpose associated with the
13 development of distinctive license plates. All expenditures from the
14 distinctive license plate application fee fund shall be made in
15 accordance with appropriation acts, upon warrants of the director of
16 accounts and reports issued pursuant to vouchers approved by the
17 secretary of the department of revenue.

18 (g) (1) Except for educational institution license plates issued
19 under K.S.A. 8-1,142, and amendments thereto, the director of
20 vehicles shall discontinue the issuance of any distinctive license plate
21 authorized prior to July 1, 2004, and which is subject to the provisions
22 of subsection (b) if:

23 (A) Less than 500 license plates, including annual renewals, are
24 issued for that distinctive license plate by July 1, 2006; and

25 (B) less than 250 license plates, including annual renewals, are
26 issued for that distinctive license plate during any subsequent two-
27 year period after July 1, 2006.

28 (2) The director of vehicles shall discontinue the issuance of any
29 distinctive license plate authorized on and after July 1, 2004, if:

30 (A) Less than 500 plates, including annual renewals, are issued
31 for that distinctive license plate by the end of the second year of sales;
32 and

33 (B) less than 250 license plates, including annual renewals, are
34 issued for that distinctive license plate during any subsequent two-
35 year period.

36 (h) *An application for any distinctive license plate issued after*
37 *December 31, 2012, and the corresponding royalty fee may be collected*
38 *either by the county treasurer or the entity benefiting from the issuance of*
39 *the distinctive license plate. Annual royalty payments collected by the*
40 *county treasurers shall be remitted to the state treasurer in accordance*
41 *with the provisions of K.S.A. 75-4215, and amendments thereto. Upon*
42 *receipt of each such remittance the state treasurer shall deposit the entire*
43 *amount in the state treasury to the credit of a segregated royalty fund*

1 *which shall be administered by the state treasurer. All expenditures from*
2 *the royalty fund shall be made in accordance with appropriation acts upon*
3 *warrants of the director of accounts and reports issued pursuant to*
4 *vouchers approved by the state treasurer {or the state treasurer's*
5 **designee}. Payments ~~from~~ {from} the royalty fund shall be made to the**
6 *entity benefiting from the issuance of the distinctive license plate on a*
7 *monthly basis.*

8 **Sec. 2.** K.S.A. 2011 Supp. 8-1,142 is hereby amended to read as
9 follows: 8-1,142. (a) As used in this section, "educational institution"
10 means:

11 (1) Any state educational institution under the control and supervision
12 of the state board of regents;

13 (2) any municipal university;

14 (3) any not-for-profit independent institution of higher education
15 which is accredited by the north central association of colleges and
16 secondary schools accrediting agency based on its requirements as of April
17 1, 1985, is operated independently and not controlled or administered by
18 the state or any agency or subdivision thereof, maintains open enrollment
19 and the main campus or principal place of operation of which is located in
20 Kansas;

21 (4) any community college organized and operating under the laws of
22 this state; and

23 (5) Haskell Indian Nations university.

24 (b) Any owner or lessee of one or more passenger vehicles or trucks
25 registered for a gross weight of not more than 20,000 pounds who is a
26 resident of Kansas, upon compliance with the provisions of this section,
27 may be issued one educational institution license plate for each such
28 passenger vehicle or truck. Such license plates shall be issued for the same
29 period of time as other license plates upon proper registration and payment
30 of the regular license fee as provided in K.S.A. 8-143, and amendments
31 thereto, plus the payment of an additional fee of \$5 for each plate, and the
32 presentation of the annual emblem use authorization statement provided
33 for in subsection (c). *Presentation of the annual emblem use authorization*
34 *statement shall not be required by the county treasurer if the emblem use*
35 *royalty payment is paid to the county treasurer.*

36 (c) Any educational institution may authorize through its officially
37 recognized alumni association or foundation the use of such institution's
38 official emblems to be affixed on license plates as provided by this section.
39 Any royalty payment to such alumni association ~~or~~, foundation *or county*
40 *treasurer* derived from this section, except reasonable administrative costs,
41 shall be used for recognition of academic achievement or excellence
42 subject to the approval of the chancellor or president of the educational
43 institution. Any motor vehicle owner or lessee may annually apply to the

1 alumni association ~~or~~, foundation *or county treasurer* for the use of the
2 institution's emblems. Upon annual application and payment to the alumni
3 association ~~or~~ foundation *or county treasurer* in an amount of not less than
4 \$25 nor more than \$100 as an emblem use royalty payment for each
5 educational institution license plate to be issued, the alumni association or
6 foundation shall issue to the motor vehicle owner or lessee, without further
7 charge, an emblem use authorization statement, which shall be presented
8 by the motor vehicle owner or lessee at the time of registration.
9 *Presentation of the annual emblem use authorization statement shall not*
10 *be required by the county treasurer if the emblem use royalty payment is*
11 *paid to the county treasurer.*

12 (d) Any applicant for an educational institution license plate may
13 make application for such plates not less than 60 days prior to such
14 person's renewal of registration date, on a form prescribed and furnished
15 by the director of vehicles, and any applicant for the educational institution
16 license plates shall provide the annual emblem use authorization statement
17 provided for in subsection (c). Application for registration of a passenger
18 vehicle or truck and issuance of the license plates under this section shall
19 be made by the owner or lessee in a manner prescribed by the director of
20 vehicles upon forms furnished by the director.

21 (e) No registration or educational institution license plate issued
22 under this section shall be transferable to any other person.

23 (f) *The director of vehicles may transfer educational institution*
24 *license plates from a leased vehicle to a purchased vehicle.*

25 (g) Renewals of registration under this section shall be made
26 annually, upon payment of the fee prescribed in subsection (b), in the
27 manner prescribed in subsection (b) of K.S.A. 8-132, and amendments
28 thereto. No renewal of registration shall be made to any applicant until
29 such applicant *either* provides the annual emblem use authorization
30 statement provided for in subsection (c) *or makes the annual emblem use*
31 *royalty payment directly to the county treasurer.* If such emblem use
32 authorization statement is not presented at the time of registration *or faxed*
33 *by the alumni association or foundation, or the annual emblem use royalty*
34 *payment is not made to the county treasurer,* the applicant shall be required
35 to comply with K.S.A. 8-143, and amendments thereto, and return the
36 educational institution license plates to the county treasurer of such
37 person's residence.

38 ~~(g)~~(h) The director of vehicles shall not issue any educational
39 institution license plates for any educational institution, unless such
40 educational institution's alumni association or foundation guarantees the
41 initial issuance of at least 500 license plates.

42 ~~(h)~~(i) The director of vehicles shall discontinue the issuance of an
43 educational institution's license plate authorized under this section if:

1 (1) Less than 500 educational institution license plates, including
2 annual renewals, are issued for an educational institution by the end of the
3 second year of sales; and

4 (2) less than 250 educational institution license plates, including
5 annual renewals, are issued for an educational institution during any
6 subsequent two-year period.

7 ~~(i)~~(j) Each educational institution's alumni association or foundation
8 shall:

9 (1) Pay the initial cost of silk-screening for such educational license
10 plates; and

11 (2) provide to all county treasurers a toll-free telephone number
12 where applicants can call the alumni association or foundation for
13 information concerning the application process or the status of their
14 license plate application.

15 ~~(j)~~(k) Each educational institution's alumni association or foundation,
16 with the approval of the director of vehicles and subject to the availability
17 of materials and equipment, shall design a license plate to be issued under
18 the provisions of this section.

19 (l) *As a condition of receiving the educational institution license plate
20 and any subsequent registration renewal of such plate, the applicant must
21 provide consent to the division authorizing the division's release of motor
22 vehicle record information, including the applicant's name, address,
23 emblem use royalty payment amount, plate number and vehicle type to the
24 relevant educational institution and the state treasurer.*

25 (m) *Annual royalty payments collected by county treasurers under
26 this section shall be remitted to the state treasurer in accordance with the
27 provisions of K.S.A. 75-4215, and amendments thereto. In the case of an
28 educational institution that is a state educational institution as defined by
29 K.S.A. 76-711, and amendments thereto, upon receipt of each such
30 remittance, the state treasurer shall deposit the entire amount in the state
31 treasury to the credit of the appropriate account of the restricted fees fund
32 of such state educational institution. In the case of an educational
33 institution which is not a state educational institution as defined by K.S.A.
34 76-711, and amendments thereto, upon receipt of each such remittance,
35 the state treasurer shall remit the entire amount to the educational
36 institutions emblem royalty fund, which is hereby created in the state
37 treasury and shall be administered by the state treasurer. All expenditures
38 from the educational institutions emblem royalty fund shall be made in
39 accordance with appropriation acts upon warrants of the director of
40 accounts and reports issued pursuant to vouchers approved by the state
41 treasurer or the state treasurer's designee. Payments from the educational
42 institutions emblem royalty fund to the respective educational institutions
43 shall be made on a monthly basis.*

21 in accordance with the provisions of paragraph (2) of subsection (c) of
22 K.S.A. 38-1808, and amendments thereto. Any motor vehicle owner or
23 lessee may annually apply to the ~~committee~~*cabinet or county treasurer* for
