AN ACT concerning county treasurers; amending K.S.A. 19-501 and repealing the existing section.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

5 Section 1. K.S.A. 19-501 is hereby amended to read as follows: 19-501. Each county treasurer elected at the general election in 19762008 6 7 shall serve until the second Tuesday in October of 1981Monday in 8 January of 2013 and until a successor is elected and qualified. At the 9 general election in 19802016, and every four (4) years thereafter, a county treasurer shall be elected in each county for a term of four (4) years, 10 commencing on the second Tuesday in OctoberMonday in January 11 12 following the election, and until a successor is elected and qualified. Such 13 county treasurer shall, before entering upon the duties, of the office, shall 14 execute to the state of Kansas a corporate surety bond issued by a 15 company authorized to do business in this state and approved by the board 16 of county commissioners in an amount of not less than twenty-five-17 thousand dollars (\$25,000)\$25,000. Such bond, with the approval of the 18 board endorsed thereon by the clerk, shall be filed in the office of the 19 county clerk. In the event If the board of commissioners shall not be in 20 session does not meet in time for any county treasurer to present such bond 21 for their approval as above specified, or such county treasurer shall be 22 unable, for any reason, to present such bond at any regular meeting of the 23 board after due notice of such county treasurer's election, such county 24 treasurer may present such bond to the ehairmanchairperson or clerk of 25 the board for approval, and the approval endorsed thereon shall have the 26 same effect as if done by the board of county commissioners. In the event 27 the amount of the bond is approved by only the ehairmanchairperson or 28 the clerk of the board, it shall not be less than twice the amount of all 29 moneys directed by the board to be levied in the county during the 30 previous year.

- Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
