AN ACT concerning abortion medical care facilities; relating to abortion; sterilization; amending K.S.A. 65-443, 65-446 and 65-447 and K.S.A. 2011 Supp. 65-444 and repealing the existing sections.

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Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

6 Section 1. K.S.A. 65-443 is hereby amended to read as follows: 65-7 443. No person shall be required to perform, refer for, or participate in medical procedures or in the prescription or administration of any device 8 9 or drug which result in the termination of a pregnancy or an effect of which the person reasonably believes may result in the termination of a 10 11 pregnancy, and the refusal of any person to perform, refer for, or 12 participate in those medical procedures, prescription or administration 13 shall not be a basis for civil liability to any person. No hospital, hospital 14 *health care facility, health* medical care facility, medical care facility 15 administrator or governing board of any hospital health medical care facility shall terminate the employment of, prevent or impair the practice 16 17 or occupation of or impose any other sanction on any person because of such person's refusal to perform or participate in the termination of any 18 19 human pregnancy exercise of rights protected by this section.

20 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2011 Supp. 65-444 is hereby amended to read as follows: 65-444. No hospital, hospital health care facility, health medical 21 care facility, medical care facility administrator or governing board of 22 23 any medical care facility shall be required to permit the performance, referral for, or participation in medical procedures or in the prescription 24 25 or administration of any device or drug which result in the termination of 26 human pregnancies or an effect of which the medical care facility, 27 administrator or board reasonably believes may result in the termination 28 of human pregnancies within its institution facility and the refusal to 29 permit such procedures prescription or administration shall not be grounds for civil liability to any person. A hospital medical care facility may 30 establish criteria and procedures under which pregnancies may be 31 32 terminated within its institution, in addition to those which may be 33 prescribed by licensing, regulating or accrediting agencies.

Sec. 3. K.S.A. 65-446 is hereby amended to read as follows: 65-446. No person shall be required to perform, *refer for* or participate in medical procedures which result in sterilization of a person, and the

refusal of any person to perform, refer for or participate in those 1 medical procedures shall not be a basis for civil liability to any person. 2 No hospital, hospital medical care facility, medical care facility 3 administrator or governing board of any hospital medical care facility 4 shall terminate the employment of, prevent or impair the practice or 5 6 occupation of or impose any other sanction on any person because of 7 his refusal to perform or participate in such medical procedures such 8 person's exercise of rights protected by this section.

9 Sec. 4. K.S.A. 65-447 is hereby amended to read as follows: 65-447. No hospital, hospital medical care facility, medical care facility 10 administrator, or governing board of any medical care facility shall be 11 required to permit the performance, referral for or participation in 12 medical procedures resulting in sterilization within its institution-13 facility and the refusal to permit such procedures shall not be grounds 14 15 for civil liability to any person. A hospital medical care facility may 16 establish criteria and procedures under which sterilizations may be 17 performed within its institution, in addition to those which may be 18 prescribed by licensing, regulating or accrediting agencies.

Sec. 3. 5. K.S.A. 65-443, 65-446 and 65-447 and K.S.A. 2011 Supp.
65-444 are hereby repealed.
