1 AN ACT concerning the board of accountancy; relating to the special 2 litigation reserve fund; authorizing transfers from the board of 3 accountancy fee fund; prescribing guidelines, limitations and duties 4 with respect thereto.

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Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

7 Section 1. (a) The special litigation reserve fund in the state treasury shall be administered by the board of accountancy in accordance with this 8 section. Subject to the provisions of this section, all expenditures from the 9 10 board of accountancy fee special litigation reserve fund shall be made in 11 accordance with appropriation acts upon warrants of the director of 12 accounts and reports issued pursuant to vouchers approved by the chairperson of the board of accountancy or by a person or persons 13 designated by the chairperson. 14

(b) No expenditures shall be made from the special litigation reserve
 fund, except upon the approval of the director of the budget acting after
 ascertaining that:

(1) An unforeseeable occurrence or unascertainable effects of a
foreseeable occurrence characterize the need for the requested expenditure,
and delay until the next legislative session on the requested action would
be contrary to paragraph (3) of this subsection;

(2) the requested expenditure is not one that was rejected in the next
 preceding session of the legislature and is not contrary to known
 legislative policy; and

(3) the requested action will assist the board of accountancy in
attaining an objective or goal which bears a valid relationship to powers
and functions of the board of accountancy.

28 (c) Subject to the provisions of appropriation acts, the executive 29 director of the board of accountancy, with the approval of the director of 30 the budget, may transfer moneys from the board of accountancy fee fund 31 to the special litigation reserve fund of the board of accountancy. The 32 executive director of the board of accountancy shall certify each such 33 transfer of moneys to the director of accounts and reports and shall 34 transmit a copy of each such certification to the director of the budget and 35 the director of legislative research.

36 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its

1 publication in the statute book.
