AN ACT concerning insurance; relating to the recovery of economic or 2 noneconomic loss sustained as a result of an accident while operating 3 an uninsured motor vehicle.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

6 Section 1. (a) Any person who, at the time of an automobile accident 7 resulting in injuries to that person, is required but fails to maintain 8 personal injury protection benefits coverage mandated by the Kansas 9 automobile injury reparations act, article 31 of chapter 40 of the Kansas 10 Statutes Annotated, and amendments thereto, shall have no cause of action 11 for recovery of noneconomic loss sustained as a result of an accident while 12 operating an uninsured automobile. The provisions of this subsection 13 shall not apply and a cause of action for noneconomic loss may be maintained if the court finds by clear and convincing evidence that the 14 person bringing the cause of action did not knowingly at the time of 15 16 the accident drive a motor vehicle that was without personal injury protection benefits coverage mandated by the Kansas automobile 17 18 injury reparations act. The provisions of this subsection shall not apply 19 to any person who at the time of an automobile accident has failed to 20 maintain coverage for a period of 30 45 days or less and who had 21 maintained continuous coverage for at least one year immediately prior to 22 such failure to maintain coverage.

23 (b) Any person who is convicted of, or pleads guilty to, a violation of 24 K.S.A. 8-1014 or 8-1567, and amendments thereto, or a similar violation 25 of law in another state or an ordinance of any city, or resolution of any 26 county, in connection with an accident, shall have no cause of action for 27 recovery of noneconomic loss sustained as a result of the accident.

28 (c) The provisions of this section shall apply to a cause of action 29 arising on and after the effective date of this act.

30 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 31 publication in the statute book.
