AN ACT concerning public works projects for state agencies; prescribing
 payment of minimum wages for work thereon and preferences for
 certain employees to work thereon.

- 5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) Each contract entered into by any state agency 6 for any nonfederal aid, public works project shall be based on bid or 7 contract specifications prescribing and requiring that employees of any 8 contractor or subcontractor shall be paid not less than the hourly wages, 9 10 including fringe benefits, paid to corresponding classes of laborers and 11 mechanics employed on similar projects in the county where the project 12 is to be performed. Such minimum wage shall be the wage paid to the majority of the laborers or mechanics, unless the same wages are not paid 13 to a majority, in which case the minimum wage shall be the average 14 15 wages paid, weighted by the total employed in the classification. In the alternative, the minimum wage shall be the wage determined under 16 17 federal law which would be required to be paid on federally funded projects at the location of the public works project. 18

19 (b) Employees employed by contractors or subcontractors in 20 the execution of any nonfederal aid, public works project contract with 21 any state agency shall be paid not less than the wages as determined 22 pursuant to subsection (a).

(c) Contractors who employ Kansas residents exclusively shall
be preferred over other bidders for public works projects owned by or
built for any state agency.
