1 AN ACT concerning state governmental ethics; relating to state officers
2 and employees; relating to lobbyists; amending K.S.A. 46-232 and
3 repealing the existing section.

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5 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

6 Section 1. K.S.A. 46-232 is hereby amended to read as follows: 46-
7 232. (a) No state officer or employee shall engage in lobbying ~~hissuch~~
8 *officer's or employee's* own state agency, if ~~hesuch officer or employee~~
9 accepts compensation specifically attributable to such lobbying, other
10 than that provided for the performance of ~~hissuch officer's or employee's~~
11 official duties. Nothing in this section shall prohibit a state officer or
12 employee from lobbying without compensation other than that which
13 ~~hesuch officer or employee~~ is entitled to receive for performance of
14 ~~hissuch officer's or employee's~~ official duties.

15 (b) *On and after January 1, 2012, no individual shall engage in*
16 *lobbying or be employed as a lobbyist within two years following:*

17 (1) *The date of resignation from or the expiration of a term of*
18 *any state office to which the individual was appointed by the governor;*

19 (2) *the date of resignation from or the expiration of a term of office*
20 *in the state legislature to which such individual was elected or appointed;*
21 *or*

22 (3) *the date of resignation from or the expiration of a term of*
23 *elected state office to which such individual was elected or appointed.*

24 (c) *For the purposes of this section, the term "elected state*
25 *office" means the governor, the lieutenant governor, the secretary of*
26 *state, the attorney general, the commissioner of insurance, the state*
27 *treasurer and any member of the state board of education.*

28 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 46-232 is hereby repealed.

1 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
2 publication in the statute book.
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
