

House Substitute for SENATE BILL No. 191

By Agriculture and Natural Resources Budget Committee

1 AN ACT making and concerning appropriations for the fiscal year ending
2 June 30, 2012, for Kansas department of agriculture; authorizing
3 certain transfers, fees, imposing certain restrictions and limitations, and
4 directing or authorizing certain receipts, disbursements, procedures and
5 acts incidental to the foregoing.

7 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

8 Section 1. (a) For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012, appropriations
9 are hereby made, restrictions and limitations are hereby imposed, and
10 transfers, capital improvement projects, fees, receipts, disbursements and
11 acts incidental to the foregoing are hereby directed or authorized as
12 provided in this act.

13 (b) This act shall not be subject to the provisions of subsection (a) of
14 K.S.A. 75-6702, and amendments thereto.

16 KANSAS DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE

17 (a) There is appropriated for the above agency from the following
18 special revenue fund or funds for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012, all
19 moneys now or hereafter lawfully credited to and available in such fund or
20 funds, except that expenditures other than refunds authorized by law shall
21 not exceed the following:

22 Laboratory testing services fee fund.....No limit

23 *Provided*, That all expenditures from the laboratory testing services fee
24 fund shall be for the purposes of providing laboratory testing of samples
25 from other states upon request: *Provided further*, That the secretary of
26 agriculture is hereby authorized to fix, charge and collect fees for such
27 laboratory testing: *And provided further*, That such fees shall be fixed in
28 order to recover all or part of the costs incurred to provide the services and
29 any other necessary and incidental expenses incurred in conjunction with
30 such laboratory testing: *And provided further*, That all moneys received
31 for such fees shall be deposited in the state treasury in accordance with the
32 provisions of K.S.A. 75-4215, and amendments thereto, and shall be
33 credited to the laboratory testing services fee fund: *And provided further*,
34 That the secretary of agriculture may adopt rules and regulations to
35 establish fees and to implement and administer the provisions of this section
36 for such laboratory testing.
