AN ACT concerning mammography examinations; providing for certain 2 information and notice to the patient.

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4 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

5 Section 1. (a) Each mammography report sent to a patient in this state pursuant to regulations implementing the federal mammography 6 7 quality standards act promulgated by the United States food and drug administration shall include information regarding breast density, based on 8 9 the breast imaging reporting and database system established by the American college of radiology. The In those patients whose 10 mammograms demonstrate that they have heterogeneously dense or 11 12 extremely dense breast tissue, the report shall include the following 13 notice:

14 "If your mammogram demonstrates that you have dense breast tissue, 15 which could hide abnormalities, you may benefit from supplemental screening tests depending on your individual risk factors. Dense breast 16 tissue, in and of itself, is a relatively common condition. Therefore, this 17 statement is not provided to cause undue concern, but rather to raise your 18 awareness of the limitations of mammography testing and to promote-19 discussion with your physician regarding the presence of other risk factors, 20 in addition to dense breast tissue, that may warrant supplemental-21 screening. A report of your mammography results, which contains-22 information about your breast density, has been sent to your physician's 23 office and you should contact your physician if you have any questions or 24 concerns regarding this report."Your mammogram demonstrates that you 25 have dense breast tissue. Mammography has known limitations, and in 26 27 women who have dense breast tissue, some abnormalities may be A report of your mammography results, which includes 28 hidden. 29 information about your breast tissue density, has been sent to your physician. This statement is intended to raise your awareness and 30 promote discussion with your physician regarding your test results. 31 Depending on your individual risk factors, your physician might 32 33 recommend additional tests. You should contact your physician if you have any questions or concerns regarding your report." 34

(b) The state board of healing arts, in conjunction with the department 35 of health and environment, shall develop and make available to the public 36
