SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2551

As Recommended by House Committee on
Agriculture and Natural Resources

Brief*

HB 2551 would authorize the Department of Wildlife, Parks and Tourism to raise the fee on the registration of water vessels to a maximum of \$60. The current maximum for such registrations is \$30. The actual fee would be set through rules and regulations of the Department.

Background

The bill was introduced at the request of a representative from the Kansas Department of Wildlife, Parks and Tourism. The registration fees cover a three-year registration period, and the current fee level is at the current statutory maximum of \$30. However, the Department indicated that it is not their intent to raise the fee in the immediate future.

In the fiscal note, the Department of Revenue indicated that passage of the bill would have no immediate fiscal effect.
