A RESOLUTION urging congress to amend the federal highway 1 2 beautification act to allow businesses in small towns across Kansas to 3 advertise with outdoor highway advertising signs. 4 5 WHEREAS, Outdoor highway advertising signs are very important to 6 attract motorists to businesses and cultural activities in small towns in 7 Kansas; and 8 WHEREAS. The highway beautification act and the regulations 9 promulgated thereunder allow the federal government to withhold federal 10 highway funding if a state engages in so called "spot zoning" or allows 11 nonconforming signs; and 12 WHEREAS, Many small town businesses have not had an opportunity 13 to "grandfather in" their outdoor advertising signs under the federal 14 highway beautification act because highways have been rerouted 15 necessitating new signs; and 16 WHEREAS, Because of the "grandfathering" process, many small 17 towns in other states have multiple outdoor advertising signs in rural areas 18 without negative effects: Now, therefore, 19 Be it resolved by the Senate of the State of Kansas: That the highway 20 beautification act should be amended to allow outdoor highway 21 advertising signs in rural areas; and 22 Be it further resolved: That the Secretary of the Senate shall send an 23 enrolled copy of this resolution to the United States department of 24 transportation and the members of the Kansas Congressional Delegation. 25
