84-9-401. Alienability of debtor's rights. (a) **Other law governs alienability; exceptions.** Except as otherwise provided in subsection (b) and K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 84-9-406, 84-9-407, 84-9-408, and 84-9-409, and amendments thereto, whether a debtor's rights in collateral may be voluntarily or involuntarily transferred is governed by law other than this article.

(b) **Agreement does not prevent transfer.** An agreement between the debtor and the secured party which prohibits a transfer of the debtor's rights in collateral or makes the transfer a default does not prevent the transfer from taking effect.
