





By 2018, **64%** of jobs in Kansas will require postsecondary education.

This is 1 percentage point above the national average of 63%.

Kansas ranks **13th** in postsecondary education intensity for 2018.

Kansas needs 64% of workers to have a post secondary certificate or degree.

- Approximately 40% need to be bachelor degrees or higher
- Approximately 24% need to have a certificate or associate degree


Current status in Kansas is.....

• Just under 40% of all Kansas students graduating high school earn any type of post secondary completion (6 years post high school graduation).


