MR. CHAIRMAN:

I move to amend HB 2201, as amended by House Committee, on page 2, following line 27, by inserting:

- "Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 12-5366 is hereby amended to read as follows: 12-5366. (a) There is hereby established in the state treasury the 911 state maintenance fund.
- (b) The chair of the 911 coordinating council shall serve as the administrator of the 911 state maintenance fund and shall distribute grants in accordance with the recommendations of the 911 coordinating council. Subject to the conditions and in accordance with the requirements of this act and 47 C.F.R. part 400, the chair is authorized to perform such acts necessary for the effectuation of this act.
 - (c) Moneys from the following sources shall be credited to the fund:
- (1) Amounts appropriated or otherwise made available by the legislature for the purposes of the fund;
 - (2) interest attributable to investment of moneys in the fund; and
 - (3) amounts received from any public or private entity for the purposes of the fund: and
- (4) any moneys transferred from the Kansas universal service fund pursuant to K.S.A. 66-2008, and amendments thereto.
 - (d) Moneys credited to the fund shall be used only:
 - (1) To pay all expenses incurred in the administration of the fund; and
- (2) to provide grants to eligible municipalities only for necessary and reasonable costs incurred or to be incurred by PSAPs for: (A) Implementation of enhanced 911 service and next

generation 911 service, as defined in K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 12-5363, and amendments thereto; (B) purchase of equipment and upgrades and modification to equipment used solely to process the data elements of enhanced 911 service and next generation 911 service, as defined in K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 12-5363, and amendments thereto; and (C) maintenance and license fees for such equipment and training of personnel to operate such equipment, including costs of training PSAP personnel to provide effective service to all users of the emergency telephone system who have communications disabilities. Such costs shall not include expenditures to lease, construct, expand, acquire, remodel, renovate, repair, furnish or make improvements to buildings or similar facilities or for other capital outlay or equipment not expressly authorized by this act.

- (e) On or before the 10th of each month, the director of accounts and reports shall transfer from the state general fund to the 911 state maintenance fund interest earnings based on:
- (1) The average daily balance of moneys in the 911 state maintenance fund for the preceding month; and
 - (2) the net earnings rate of the pooled money investment portfolio for the preceding month.
- (f) All payments and disbursements from the fund shall be made in accordance with appropriation acts upon warrants of the director of accounts and reports issued pursuant to vouchers approved by the chair or by a person or persons designated by the chair.
 - (g) This section shall take effect on and after January 1, 2012.";

And by renumbering sections accordingly;

On page 28, following line 1, by inserting:

"(h) Between March 1, 2014 and March 1, 2016, 50% of any reduction in the obligations and disbursements from the fund for the previous KUSF year shall instead be included in the required contribution for that KUSF year and shall be transferred to the 911 state maintenance fund established in K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 12-5366, and amendments thereto, for distribution to PSAPs for implementation

of next generation 911 service, as defined in K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 12-5363, and amendments thereto.";
On page 30, in line 42, after "Supp." by inserting "12-5366, ";
Also on page 1, in the title, in line 5, after "Supp." by inserting "12-5366,"
