8	Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:
9	Section 1. K.S.A. 74-3241 is hereby amended to read as follows: 74-
10	3241. (a) On July 1, 1975, persons who, prior to said date, had qualified
11	for and been designated as state scholars pursuant to the provisions of
12	article 68 of chapter 72 of the Kansas Statutes Annotated, or had been
13	awarded tuition grants pursuant to the provisions of article 61 of chapter
14	72 of the Kansas Statutes Annotated, or had received a loan from an-
15	eligible lending institution guaranteed under the provisions of article 74 of
16	chapter 72 of the Kansas Statutes Annotated and amendments thereto,
17	shall retain all benefits or rights which had accrued to or vested in such
18	persons prior to July 1, 1975.
19	(b) Persons or institutions participating in grant programs or having
20	been allocated funds under any of the federal higher education acts-
21	described in K.S.A. 72-6210, prior to its repeal, shall retain all benefits or
22	rights which had accrued to or vested in such persons or institutions unless
23	revised or nullified in accordance with law.
24	(c) All applications made pursuant to any of the programs or acts-
25	referred to in this section submitted to the state education commission-
26	prior to the effective date of this order shall continue in effect and shall be
27	deemed to have been made or submitted to the state board of regents and
28	shall be deemed sufficient for the purpose thereof. Any application for
29	grants of federal funds included with or in a state plan or pursuant to any
30	federal legislation submitted to any federal agency by the state education
31	commission prior to the effective date of this order shall continue in effect

Section 1. K.S.A. 74-2134 is hereby amended to read as follows: 74-2 2134. (a) There is hereby created in the state treasury the highway patrol 3 training center fund. All moneys credited to such fund under the 4 provisions of this act or any other law shall be expended only for the 5 6 purpose and in the manner prescribed by law. All expenditures from the 7 highway patrol training center fund shall be made in accordance with 8 appropriation acts upon warrants of the director of accounts and reports issued pursuant to vouchers approved by the superintendent of the 9 highway patrol or the designee of the superintendent. All moneys received 10 for the highway patrol training center fund shall be deposited in the state 11 treasury in accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 75-4215, and 12 amendments thereto, and shall be credited to the highway patrol training 13 14 center fund.

(b) Commencing on June 30, 1992, and on each June 30 thereafter,
the director of accounts and reports shall transfer from the highway patrol
training center fund to the state general fund \$500,000.

(c) All amounts transferred from the highway patrol training center 18 fund to the state general fund under subsection (b) are to reimburse the 19 20 state general fund for the cost of financing the training of the personnel of 21 the Kansas highway patrol which is financed from the state general fund 22 and for accounting, auditing, budgeting, legal, payroll, personnel and-23 purchasing services and any other governmental services which areperformed on behalf of the state agency involved by other state agencies 24 which receive appropriations from the state general fund to provide such 25 services. Such reimbursements are in addition to those authorized by-26 27 K.S.A. 75-3170a, and amendments thereto.
