1 AN ACT concerning the secretary of state, relating to ballot language 2 statements.

4 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) A county election officer-may shall may request the
preparation of a ballot language statement for the purposes of explaining
the language of a ballot question of any municipality as defined by K.S.A.
75-6102, and amendments thereto.

9 (1) {If a request is submitted pursuant to subsection (a) and} if the ballot question language was derived from a petition submitted to the 10 office of the county attorney, district attorney or county counselor pursuant 11 to K.S.A. 25-3601, and amendments thereto, such county election officer 12 shall, within 10 days of certification, request-from the office of the 13 14 county attorney, district attorney or county counselor, as applicable, to prepare the ballot language statement in compliance with the requirements 15 of subsection (a)(3). 16

17 (2) {*If a request is submitted pursuant to subsection (a) and*} if the 18 ballot question language did not derive from a petition submitted to the 19 office of the county attorney, district attorney or county counselor pursuant 20 to K.S.A. 25-3601, and amendments thereto, such county election officer 21 shall, within 10 days of publication, request the office of secretary of 22 state to prepare the ballot language statement in compliance with the 23 requirements of subsection (a)(3).

(3) A ballot language statement shall fairly and accurately explain what a vote for and what a vote against the measure represents. Such ballot language statements shall be true and impartial statements of the effect of a vote for and against the measure in language neither intentionally argumentative nor likely to create prejudice for or against the proposed measure. A ballot language statement shall be prepared and transmitted in good faith and without malice.

1 (b) (1) Within 15 days of a request by a county election officer to 2 prepare a ballot language statement pursuant to subsection (a)(1), the 3 office of the county attorney, district attorney or county counselor, as 4 applicable, shall prepare and forward such ballot language statement to the 5 office of secretary of state for approval by the secretary of state or the 6 secretary of state's designee that such ballot language statement complies 7 with the requirements of subsection (a)(3). Within five days following the 8 receipt of the ballot language statement, the office of secretary of state 9 shall furnish the county election officer with the ballot language statement 10 as approved by the office of secretary of state as in compliance with the requirements of subsection (a)(3). 11

12 (2) Within 15 days of a request by a county election officer to prepare 13 a ballot language statement pursuant to subsection (a)(2), the secretary of state or the secretary's designee shall prepare and forward such ballot 14 15 language statement to the office of the attorney general for approval by the 16 attorney general, or any assistant attorney general, that such ballot 17 language statement complies with the requirements of subsection (a)(3). 18 Within five days following the receipt of the ballot language statement, the 19 office of the attorney general shall furnish the county election officer with 20 the ballot language statement as approved by the office of the attorney 21 general as in compliance with the requirements of subsection (a)(3).

A ballot language statement prepared under this section shall be: (c)

(1) Posted in each polling place, but shall not be placed on the ballot;

24 (2) provided to registered voters voting by advance ballot. Such ballot 25 language statement shall not be placed on the ballot when provided to a 26 registered voter voting by advance ballot: and

27 (3) made available for public inspection in the office of the county 28 election officer. A ballot language statement prepared under this section 29 may be posted on the official website of the county.

30 (d) There shall be no cause of action at law or in equity challenging 31 the validity of the form of a ballot language statement prepared under this 32 section. There shall be no liability on the part of and no cause of action of 33 any nature shall arise against the attorney general, any assistant attorney 34 general, the secretary of state, the secretary of state's employees, the 35 county election officer, the county attorney, the district attorney or the 36 county counselor as a result of the preparation of a ballot language 37 statement under this section. The preparation of a ballot language 38 statement shall not form any basis for an election contest or result in the 39 waiver of any immunity by the state or any of its subdivisions.
