AN ACT concerning motor vehicles; relating to distinctive license plates;
 providing for the Eisenhower foundation license plate.

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Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

5 Section 1. (a) On and after January 1, 2014, any owner or lessee of one or more passenger vehicles, trucks registered for a gross weight of 6 7 20,000 pounds or less or motorcycles, who is a resident of Kansas, upon 8 compliance with the provisions of this section, may be issued one 9 Eisenhower foundation license plate for each such passenger vehicle, truck or motorcycle. Such license plates shall be issued for the same time as 10 other license plates upon proper registration and payment of the regular 11 12 license fee as provided in K.S.A. 8-143, and amendments thereto, and 13 either the payment to the county treasurer of the logo use royalty payment 14 established by the Eisenhower foundation or the presentation of the annual 15 logo use authorization statement provided for in subsection (b).

16 (b) The board of directors of the Eisenhower foundation may 17 authorize the use of their logo to be affixed on license plates as provided 18 by this section. Any royalty payment received pursuant to this section shall 19 be used to support the Eisenhower foundation. Any motor vehicle owner 20 or lessee annually may apply to the Eisenhower foundation for the use of 21 such logo. Upon annual application and payment to either: (1) The 22 Eisenhower foundation in an amount of not less than \$25 nor more than 23 \$100 as a logo use royalty payment for each license plate to be issued, the 24 Eisenhower foundation shall issue to the motor vehicle owner or lessee, 25 without further charge, a logo use authorization statement, which shall be 26 presented by the motor vehicle owner or lessee at the time of registration; 27 or (2) the county treasurer of the logo use royalty payment for each license 28 plate to be issued.

(c) Any applicant for a license plate authorized by this section may make application for such plates not less than 60 days prior to such person's renewal of registration date, on a form prescribed and furnished by the director of vehicles, and any applicant for such license plate shall either provide the annual logo use authorization statement provided for in subsection (b) or pay to the county treasurer the logo use royalty payment
 established by the Eisenhower foundation. Application for registration of a
 passenger vehicle, truck or motorcycle and issuance of the license plate
 under this section shall be made by the owner or lessee in a manner
 prescribed by the director of vehicles upon forms furnished by the director.

6 (d) No registration or license plate issued under this section shall be 7 transferable to any other person.

8 (e) The director of vehicles may transfer the Eisenhower foundation 9 license plates from a leased vehicle to a purchased vehicle.

10 (f) Renewals of registration under this section shall be made annually, upon payment of the fee prescribed in subsection (a), in the manner 11 prescribed in subsection (b) of K.S.A. 8-132, and amendments thereto. No 12 renewal of registration shall be made to any applicant until such applicant 13 either provides to the county treasurer either the annual logo use 14 authorization statement provided for in subsection (b) or the payment of 15 the logo use royalty payment as established by the Eisenhower foundation. 16 17 If such logo use authorization statement is not presented at the time of 18 registration or faxed by the Eisenhower foundation, or the annual logo use 19 royalty payment is not made to the county treasurer at the time of 20 registration, the applicant shall be required to comply with K.S.A. 8-143, 21 and amendments thereto, and return the license plate to the county 22 treasurer of such person's residence.

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(g) The Eisenhower foundation shall:

(1) Pay the initial cost of silk-screening for license plates authorizedby this section; and

(2) provide to all county treasurers a toll-free telephone number
 where applicants can call the Eisenhower foundation for information
 concerning the application process or the status of their license plate
 application.

(h) The Eisenhower foundation, with the approval of the director of
vehicles and subject to the availability of materials and equipment, shall
design a plate to be issued under the provisions of this section.

(i) As a condition of receiving the Eisenhower foundation license
plate and any subsequent registration renewal of such plate, the applicant
must provide consent to the division authorizing the division's release of
motor vehicle record information, including the applicant's name, address,
logo use royalty payment amount, plate number and vehicle type to the
Eisenhower foundation and the state treasurer.

(j) Annual logo use royalty payments collected by county treasurers
under this section shall be remitted to the state treasurer in accordance
with the provisions of K.S.A. 75-4215, and amendments thereto. Upon
receipt of each such remittance the state treasurer shall deposit the entire
amount in the state treasury to the credit of the Eisenhower foundation

royalty fund, which is hereby created in the state treasury and shall be 1 administered by the state treasurer. All expenditures from the Eisenhower 2 foundation royalty fund shall be made in accordance with appropriation 3 acts upon warrants of the director of accounts and reports issued pursuant 4 to vouchers approved by the state treasurer or the state treasurer's 5 designee. Payments from the Eisenhower foundation royalty fund to the 6 7 appropriate designee of the Eisenhower foundation shall be made on a monthly basis. 8
