AN ACT concerning the national defense authorization act for fiscal year
 2012; relating to governmental entity actions pursuant thereto.

4 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

5 Section 1. (a) Subject to subsection (b), notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, no state agency, political subdivision, or 6 7 employee of any state agency or political subdivision acting in such 8 employee's official capacity, nor any member of the Kansas national guard 9 on official state duty shall aid an agency of the armed forces of the United States in any investigation, prosecution or detention of any person 10 pursuant to section 2021 of the national defense authorization act for fiscal 11 12 year 2012, if such aid would place such state agency, political subdivision, 13 employee or member of the Kansas national guard in violation of the 14 United States constitution, the Kansas constitution or any law of this state.

(b) Subsection (a) shall not apply to participation by state or local law
enforcement agencies or the Kansas national guard in a joint task force,
partnership or other similar cooperative agreement with any federal law
enforcement agency if such joint task force, partnership or similar
cooperative agreement is not for the purpose of investigating, prosecuting
or detaining any person pursuant to section 2021 of the national defense
authorization act for fiscal year 2012.

(c) For the purposes of this section:

(1) "Political subdivision" means political or taxing subdivisions of
 the state, including boards, commissions, authorities, councils,
 committees, subcommittees and other subordinate groups or administrative
 units thereof, receiving or expending and supported in whole or in part by
 public funds.

(2) "State agency" means any state office or officer, department,
board, commission, institution, bureau or any agency, division or unit
within any office, department, board, commission or other state authority.
