AN ACT concerning the correctional industries fund; authorizing use of
funds for workers compensation insurance; amending K.S.A. 2013
Supp. 75-5282 and repealing the existing section.

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Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

6 Section 1. K.S.A. 2013 Supp. 75-5282 is hereby amended to read as 7 follows: 75-5282. (a) There is hereby created in the state treasury the 8 correctional industries fund.

9 (b) All moneys collected by the secretary from the sale or disposition of goods manufactured and services provided under the prison-made goods 10 act shall be remitted to the state treasurer in accordance with the 11 12 provisions of K.S.A. 75-4215, and amendments thereto. Upon receipt of 13 each such remittance, the state treasurer shall deposit the entire amount in 14 the state treasury to the credit of the correctional industries fund. All the 15 moneys collected and deposited pursuant to this subsection shall be used 16 solely for the purchase of manufacturing supplies, equipment and 17 machinery, for the repair, maintenance and replacement of equipment and 18 machinery, for administrative expenses and as provided in subsection (d).

(c) The balance of all proceeds from the lease of agricultural land at a correctional institution, after payment of the expenses of the lease from such proceeds, shall be remitted to the state treasurer in accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 75-4215, and amendments thereto. Upon receipt of each such remittance, the state treasurer shall deposit the entire amount in the state treasury to the credit of the correctional industries fund.

25 (d) Any unencumbered moneys in the correctional industries fund 26 may be expended for capital improvement projects for the renovation or 27 repair of existing buildings or facilities or for the construction or 28 acquisition of building or facilities for correctional industries as provided 29 in K.S.A. 75-5281 and 75-5288, and amendments thereto. Such capital 30 improvement projects shall not be subject to the requirements to prepare 31 and submit capital improvement budget estimates as provided in K.S.A. 32 75-3717b, and amendments thereto. Prior to commencement of a capital 33 improvement project, the director of Kansas correctional industries shall 34 advise and consult with the joint committee on state building construction 35 concerning such capital improvement projects.

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(e) Moneys in the correctional industries fund may be used for

1 purchase of workers compensation insurance for inmates assigned to a

2 duly certified prison industry enhancement certification program (PIECP)

3 customer model industry owned and operated by Kansas correctional

4 industries pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 1761, and K.S.A. 75-5275, and 5 amendments thereto. Subject to PIECP wage-level requirements, such

6 inmates shall otherwise be considered to be in the same status as inmates

7 assigned to a traditional industries program operated by Kansas

8 correctional industries. Such inmates shall not be regarded as state

9 *employees for any purpose under state law.*

10 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2013 Supp. 75-5282 is hereby repealed.

11 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 12 publication in the statute book.
