1 AN ACT concerning certain statewide elected officials; amending K.S.A.
2 25-101b and 25-4001 and repealing the existing sections.

4 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

5 Section 1. K.S.A. 25-101b is hereby amended to read as follows: 25-
6 101b. (a) At the general election held in 1978 and each four (~~4~~)-years
7 thereafter, there shall be elected a treasurer for the state of Kansas, whose
8 term of office shall be four (~~4~~)-years beginning on the second Monday in
9 January next succeeding such treasurer's election. In case of a vacancy in
10 such office, the governor shall appoint some suitable person to serve for
11 the unexpired term and until a successor is elected and qualified.

12 (b) *No person shall serve more than three consecutive terms as*
13 *treasurer.*

14 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 25-4001 is hereby amended to read as follows: 25-
15 4001. (a) The governor, lieutenant governor, secretary of state, attorney
16 general, state treasurer and commissioner of insurance shall be elected for
17 terms of four (~~4~~)-years, to begin on the second Monday of January next
18 after their election, and until their successors are elected and qualified.

19 (b) *No person shall serve as state treasurer or commissioner of*
20 *insurance for more than three consecutive terms.*

21 Sec. 3. K.S.A. 25-101b and 25-4001 are hereby repealed.

22 Sec. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
23 publication in the statute book.
