**HB 2136 - Designating a portion of US 400 as the 903<sup>rd</sup> ordnance ammunition co bypass**

The Chairman opened the hearing on **HB 2136** by introducing Representative Jeff Jack. (Attachment 1) Representative Jeff pointed out to the Committee that the designation should be for the 930<sup>th</sup> - not the 903<sup>rd</sup> ordnance ammunition co bypass. Representative Jack explained the bill and introduced five members of the 930<sup>th</sup> ordnance ammunition company.

There were no other proponents and no opponents.

Chairman Hayzlett closed the hearing on **HB 2136**.
