"WHEREAS, The provisions of K.S.A. 2014 Supp. 21-6811(c), as amended by this act, shall be known and may be cited as Mija Stockman's Law; Now, therefore,

".

On page 2, in line 3, by striking "An" and inserting "Any"; also in line 3, after "K.S.A." by inserting "8-2,144 or"; also in line 3, after "8-1567" by inserting "or K.S.A. 2014 Supp. 8-1025"; in line 5, by striking "the" and inserting "any"; also in line 5, after "K.S.A." by inserting "8-2,144 or"; also in line 5, after "8-1567" by inserting "or K.S.A. 2014 Supp. 8-1025"; following line 7, by inserting:

- "(3) If the current crime of conviction is for a violation of K.S.A. 2014 Supp. 21-5413(b)(3), and amendments thereto:
- (A) The first prior adult conviction, diversion in lieu of criminal prosecution or juvenile adjudication for the following shall count as one nonperson felony for criminal history purposes:

 (i) Any act described in K.S.A. 8-2,144 or 8-1567 or K.S.A. 2014 Supp. 8-1025, and amendments thereto; or (ii) a violation of a law of another state or an ordinance of any city, or resolution of any county, which prohibits any act described in K.S.A. 8-2,144 or 8-1567 or K.S.A. 2014 Supp. 8-1025, and amendments thereto; and
 - (B) each second or subsequent prior adult conviction, diversion in lieu of criminal

prosecution or juvenile adjudication for the following shall count as one person felony for criminal history purposes: (i) Any act described in K.S.A. 8-2,144 or 8-1567 or K.S.A. 2014 Supp. 8-1025, and amendments thereto; or (ii) a violation of a law of another state or an ordinance of any city, or resolution of any county, which prohibits any act described in K.S.A. 8-2,144 or 8-1567 or K.S.A. 2014 Supp. 8-1025, and amendments thereto.";

On page 1, in the title, in line 2, after "history;" by inserting "aggravated battery, driving under the influence;"; and the bill be passed as amended.
