SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2098 by Representative Lunn

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2098 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2098 would designate the portion of U.S. Highway 69 from the junction of U.S. Highway 69 and 135th Street in Johnson County south to the junction of U.S. Highway 69 and 167th Street as the 2nd Lieutenant Justin L. Sisson Memorial Highway. Signs to indicate this designation would be placed along the highway right-of-way at proper intervals by the Secretary of Transportation.

The Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) states that two signs would need to be planned, manufactured, installed, and maintained for the highway designated by HB 2098. The cost of these two signs, including installation, would be \$3,900 or \$1,950 for each sign. If the bill is enacted, KDOT states it would need an increase in expenditure authority from the agency operations account of the State Highway Fund. Any fiscal effect associated with HB 2098 is not reflected in *The FY 2016 Governor's Budget Report*.
