AN ACT concerning the student data privacy act; authorizing school districts to administer certain surveys and questionnaires; amending K.S.A. 2014 Supp. 72-6219 and repealing the existing section.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. K.S.A. 2014 Supp. 72-6219 is hereby amended to read as follows: 72-6219. (a) No test, questionnaire, survey or examination containing any questions about the student's personal beliefs or practices on issues such as sex, family life, morality or religion, or any questions about the student's parents' or guardians' beliefs and practices on issues such as sex, family life, morality or religion, shall be administered to any student enrolled in kindergarten or grades one through 12, unless the parent or guardian of the student is notified in writing that this test, questionnaire, survey or examination is to be administered and the parent or guardian of the student gives written permission for the student to take this test, questionnaire, survey or examination.

- (b) This section shall not prohibit school counselors from providing counseling services to a student, including the administration of tests and forms which are part of a counselor's student counseling services. Any information obtained through such tests or counseling services shall not be stored on any personal mobile electronic device which is not owned by the school district, including but not limited to, laptops, tablets, phones, flash drives, external hard drives or virtual servers.
- (c) The provisions of this section shall not apply to any questionnaire or survey containing questions on issues such as sex, family life, morality or religion which is administered to any student enrolled in kindergarten or grades one through 12, provided that:
- (1) Such questionnaire or survey does not record, request or solicit a student to provide any personally identifiable student data;
- (2) each student is informed that participation in such questionnaire or survey is voluntary;
- (3) the parent or legal guardian of each student is informed in advance of the questionnaire or survey that such parent or legal guardian may opt a student out of such questionnaire or survey; and
- (4) the results of such questionnaire or survey are reported only as aggregate data.
