AN ACT concerning counties; relating to expansion of the board of county
 commissioners; amending K.S.A. 2014 Supp. 19-203 and repealing the
 existing section.

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Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

6 Section 1. K.S.A. 2014 Supp. 19-203 is hereby amended to read as 7 follows: 19-203. (a) Subject to the provisions of K.S.A. 2014 Supp. 19-8 204b, and amendments thereto, when a vacancy occurs in the office of a 9 member of the board of county commissioners, it shall be filled by appointment of a resident in the district to fill the office for the unexpired 10 term and until a successor is elected and qualified. When a vacancy occurs 11 before May 1 of the first even-numbered year following the 12 13 commencement of a term of office, it shall be filled by the appointment of 14 a resident of such district who shall serve until a successor is elected and 15 qualified at the next general election. Such successor shall assume office 16 on the second Monday of January next following such election.

17 (b) Except as provided by subsection (c), appointments under this 18 section shall be made in the manner provided by K.S.A. 25-3902, and 19 amendments thereto, for filling vacancies in district offices.

20 (c) Subject to the provisions of K.S.A. 2014 Supp. 19-204b, and 21 amendments thereto, vacancies created by an increase in the number of 22 county commissioner districts in a county pursuant to K.S.A. 19-204, and 23 amendments thereto, shall be filled by appointment of the governor. The 24 governor shall make such appointments within 30 days of the date of the 25 adoption of the resolution dividing the county into commissioner districts 26 or within 30 days of the date of the order of the district court dividing the 27 county into commissioner districts as required by K.S.A. 19-204a, and 28 amendments thereto.

29 Such appointees- at a special election as provided in subsection (d).

(d) Following the certification of the election results expanding the
board of county commissioners and the adoption of the resolution dividing
the county into commissioner districts as required by K.S.A. 19-204a, and
amendments thereto, the board of county commissioners shall pass a
resolution calling for a special election to fill the vacancies. The election
shall be held within 45 days of the passage of such resolution. Candidates
for the office shall file for such offices as provided in K.S.A. 25-205, and

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1 amendments thereto. The candidate receiving the highest number of votes 2 in each commission district shall serve until successors are elected and 3 qualified at the next general election. Such successors shall assume office 4 on the second Monday of January next following their election. If at the 5 next general election following such-appointments special election, more 6 than a simple majority of commissioners are elected, persons elected to the 7 positions created by an increase in the number of districts shall be elected 8 for two year terms and until their successors are qualified. Thereafter such 9 members shall be elected to four year terms and until their successors are qualified. The provisions of this subsection shall apply to positions created 10 by an increase in the number of districts at the election held in November 11 12 1990 and all such elections thereafter.
