6 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

 35 director of accounts and reports is hereby authorized and directed to draw
 36 warrants on the state treasurer in favor of the claimants specified in this
 37 act, upon vouchers duly executed by the state agencies directed to pay the
 38 amounts specified in such sections to the claimants or their legal
 39 representatives or duly authorized agents, as provided by law.

40 (b) The director of accounts and reports shall secure prior to the
 41 payment of any amount to any claimant, other than amounts authorized to
 42 be paid pursuant to section 6, and amendments thereto, as motor-vehicle
 43 fuel tax refunds or as transactions between state agencies as provided by

1 this act, a written release and satisfaction of all claims and rights against
2 the state of Kansas and any agencies, officers and employees of the state of
3 Kansas regarding their respective claims.
