AN ACT concerning water; relating to the water appropriation act; annual water use report; amending K.S.A. 2015 Supp. 82a-732 and repealing the existing section.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. K.S.A. 2015 Supp. 82a-732 is hereby amended to read as follows: 82a-732. (a) The owner of a water right or permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, except for domestic use, shall file *or cause to be filed* an annual water use report *for the previous calendar year* on a form prescribed by the chief engineer of the division of water resources of the Kansas department of agriculture on or before March 1 following the end of the previous calendar year. The report shall completely and accurately set forth such water use information as requested by the chief engineer.

- (b) (1) Any—person failing owner of a water right or permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, except for domestic use, who fails to timely file a water use report or other documents required under the provisions of subsection (a):
- (A) Except as provided in paragraph (B), shall be subject to a civil penalty in an amount not to exceed \$250 \$1,000 \$250; or
- (B) for two or more consecutive calendar years, shall be subject to a civil penalty in an amount not to exceed \$1,000.
- (2) In addition to assessing a civil penalty as provided in this section, in the event the owner of a water right or permit to appropriate water for beneficial use fails to file or cause to be filed an annual water use report by June 1 of the calendar year in which it is due, the chief engineer may issue an order indefinitely suspending all water use under such water right or permit to appropriate water for beneficial use until such time as the annual water use report has been submitted or the chief engineer has determined that water use has been otherwise sufficiently documented with the division.
- (3) The chief engineer upon a finding that the owner of a water right or permit to appropriate water for beneficial use has failed to file *or cause* to be filed such a report may impose a civil penalty *or indefinite* suspension, or both, as provided in this section.
- (c) Any person filing a document knowing it to contain any false information as to a material matter shall be guilty of a class C

1 misdemeanor.

- (d) All fines collected by the chief engineer pursuant to this subsection section shall be remitted to the state treasurer as provided in K.S.A. 82a-731, and amendments thereto.
- (e) The provisions of this section shall be part of and supplemental to the Kansas water appropriation act, K.S.A. 82a-701 et seq., and amendment thereto.
- Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2015 Supp. 82a-732 is hereby repealed.
- 9 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
