1 AN ACT concerning postsecondary education; relating to state funding for 2 community colleges; amending K.S.A. 2015 Supp. 71-609 and 3 repealing the existing section.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

6 Section 1. K.S.A. 2015 Supp. 71-609 is hereby amended to read as 7 follows: 71-609. (a) No amount of state funding shall be based upon-8 enrollment in any subject or course the principal part of which is taught at 9 a location outside the county of the main campus of the community-10 college, unless the location of such subject or course is specifically-11 authorized by the state board of regents.

12 (b) (1) No amount of state funding shall be based upon enrollment in 13 any subject or course which is taught in a county in which the main campus of a state educational institution is located, unless the teaching of 14 such subject or course is specifically authorized by the chief executive 15 16 officer of the state educational institution or by a designee of the chief executive officer. The chief executive officer of each state educational 17 18 institution may designate and authorize a person or committee to act on 19 behalf of the chief executive officer in granting the authorizations required 20 by this subsection.

(2) For the purposes of this subsection, the term "main campus of a state educational institution" as applied to Kansas state university of agriculture and applied science means and includes the campus of the university located in Riley county and the campus of the university's college of technology located in Saline county.

(b) No postsecondary course in which secondary students may be
enrolled shall be offered when such course is offered by a state
educational institution, technical college, Washburn university or the
institute of technology at Washburn in the county of the main campus of a
community college or in the service area of a community college, unless
such course is specifically authorized by the chief executive officer of such
community college.

Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2015 Supp. 71-609 is hereby repealed.
