During the last election cycle, candidates were placing signs in medians. I do not believe that it was the intent nor the interpretation of the sign bills we as a Legislature have passed in the last few years. I do believe however, that a clarification may be needed. My intent with House Bill 2210 is simply to make it very clear that political candidates cannot place signs in medians, which is the same for all signs. The city of Olathe, for example, does not allow commercial signs, yard signs, or any signs of any nature to be placed in medians. Please help keep our city beautiful.
