

Chairman Lynn and members of the Senate Committee on Commerce, thank you for the opportunity to submit written comments in support of HB 2168. I am Leslie Kaufman, Director of Government Relations & Legal Counsel for Kansas Electric Cooperatives, Inc. (KEC).

KEC is the statewide association representing rural electric cooperatives (RECs). Our co-ops are owned and controlled by the members they serve. While RECs combine to serve roughly 80 percent of the landmass in Kansas, our customer density is sparse, averaging just 3.2 member-consumers per mile of line statewide.

One of the seven tenants of the cooperative movement is "concern for community." Our cooperative members live out that principle on a daily basis in numerous ways and many are very active in local and regional economic development activities. Creating jobs, growing the rural economy and building communities that retain and attract families is important to rural electric cooperatives.

The Ad Astra Rural Job Act creates one more tool to attract investment in rural communities, spur job creation and grow the Kansas economy. As such, we support HB 2168 and respectfully request the Committee advance the bill favorably for passage.
