My name is Tami Albin, and I am writing to express my strong opposition to HB 2042, which would greatly increase risk of injury, death, well-being, and learning on state university campuses and other public places in Kansas. As an academic librarian who is very familiar with the stress levels endured by university students, I am concerned not only by increased risks of gun violence and accidents should the restrictions be loosened to allow 18-20 year-olds to carry concealed weapons, but by the increased risks in stress levels of all students, faculty, and staff, and the increased detriment to learning that we have already seen in the months since concealed carry became a legal campus reality in 2017.
