MADAM PRESIDENT:

I move to amend **Senate Substitute for HB 2002**, on page 10, following line 43, by inserting:

"(b) Notwithstanding the provisions of K.S.A. 76-1115, and amendments thereto, or any other statute, during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018, in addition to the other purposes for which expenditures may be made by the Kansas state school for the blind from the moneys appropriated from the state general fund or from any special revenue fund or funds for fiscal year 2018 as authorized by this or other appropriation act of the 2017 regular session of the legislature, expenditures shall be made by the Kansas state school for the blind from moneys appropriated from the state general fund or from any special revenue fund or funds for fiscal year 2018 for the Kansas state school for the blind to have a superintendent of the Kansas state school for the blind that is a separate and distinct position from the superintendent appointed pursuant to K.S.A. 76-1002, and amendments thereto: *Provided*, That the superintendent positions created under K.S.A. 76-1002 and 76-1115, and amendments thereto, shall each be served by a different person.";

On page 11, following line 5, by inserting:

"(b) Notwithstanding the provisions of K.S.A. 76-1115, and amendments thereto, or any other statute, during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019, in addition to the other purposes for which expenditures may be made by the Kansas state school for the blind from the moneys appropriated from the state general fund or from any special revenue fund or funds for fiscal year 2019 as authorized by this or other appropriation act of the 2017 or 2018 regular session of the legislature, expenditures shall be made by the Kansas state school for the blind from moneys appropriated from the state general fund or from any special revenue fund or funds for fiscal year 2019 for the Kansas state school for the blind

to have a superintendent of the Kansas state school for the blind that is a separate and distinct position from the superintendent appointed pursuant to K.S.A. 76-1002, and amendments thereto: *Provided*, That the superintendent positions created under K.S.A. 76-1002 and 76-1115, and amendments thereto, shall each be served by a different person.";

Also on page 11, following line 10, by inserting:

"(b) Notwithstanding the provisions of K.S.A. 76-1002, and amendments thereto, or any other statute, during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018, in addition to the other purposes for which expenditures may be made by the Kansas state school for the deaf from the moneys appropriated from the state general fund or from any special revenue fund or funds for fiscal year 2018 as authorized by this or other appropriation act of the 2017 regular session of the legislature, expenditures shall be made by the Kansas state school for the deaf from moneys appropriated from the state general fund or from any special revenue fund or funds for fiscal year 2018 for the Kansas state school for the deaf to have a superintendent of the Kansas state school for the deaf that is a separate and distinct position from the superintendent appointed pursuant to K.S.A. 76-1115, and amendments thereto: *Provided*, That the superintendent positions created under K.S.A. 76-1002 and 76-1115, and amendments thereto, shall each be served by a different person: *Provided further*, That in selecting a superintendent of the Kansas state school for the deaf, the state board of education shall select an individual who demonstrates professional fluency in American sign language and English.";

Also on page 11, following line 15, by inserting:

"(b) Notwithstanding the provisions of K.S.A. 76-1002, and amendments thereto, or any other statute, during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019, in addition to the other purposes for which expenditures may be made by the Kansas state school for the deaf from the moneys appropriated from the state general fund or from any special revenue fund or funds for fiscal year 2019 as authorized by this or other appropriation act of the 2017 or 2018 regular session of the legislature, expenditures shall

be made by the Kansas state school for the deaf from moneys appropriated from the state general fund or from any special revenue fund or funds for fiscal year 2019 for the Kansas state school for the deaf to have a superintendent of the Kansas state school for the deaf that is a separate and distinct position from the superintendent appointed pursuant to K.S.A. 76-1115, and amendments thereto: *Provided*, That the superintendent positions created under K.S.A. 76-1002 and 76-1115, and amendments thereto, shall each be served by a different person: *Provided further*, That in selecting a superintendent of the Kansas state school for the deaf, the state board of education shall select an individual who demonstrates professional fluency in American sign language and English."
