SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2045 by House Committee on Health and Human Services

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2045 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2045 would amend statutes regarding holders of institutional licenses that were issued prior to May 9, 1997. The bill would clarify that the practice privileges of these licensees are restricted and valid only during the time that they are providing mental health services pursuant to a written protocol with a person who holds a Kansas license to practice medicine or surgery other than an institutional license.

The Kansas State Board of Healing Arts states that HB 2045 would not affect agency revenues or expenditures.
