**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for HB 2114 by House Committee on Appropriations

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2114 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2114 would exempt community mental health centers from the requirement that carrying concealed handguns cannot be prohibited unless adequate security measures are in place.

According to the Kansas Association of Counties, the bill would reduce costs for county governments and their associated community mental health centers by permanently exempting buildings of health centers from having to provide adequate security measures. However, the Association is unable to estimate the potential savings.
