**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for HB 2166 by House Committee on Energy, Utilities and Telecommunications

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2166 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2166 would amend the existing definitions of “public utility” and “retail electric supplier.” The bill would exempt entities that furnish electric vehicle charging stations from being included in those definitions, unless that entity’s otherwise subject to the jurisdiction of the Kansas Corporation Commission.

The Kansas Corporation Commission indicates that passage of HB 2166 would have no fiscal effect.
